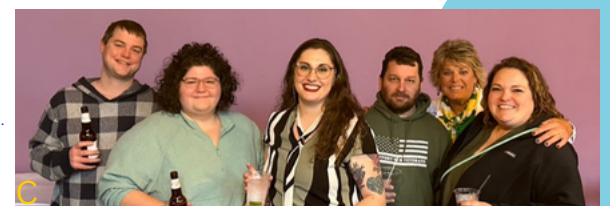


Nancy Cingolani's St. Patty's Day was The Talk of The Town!

2023 BOWL FOR BUTLER



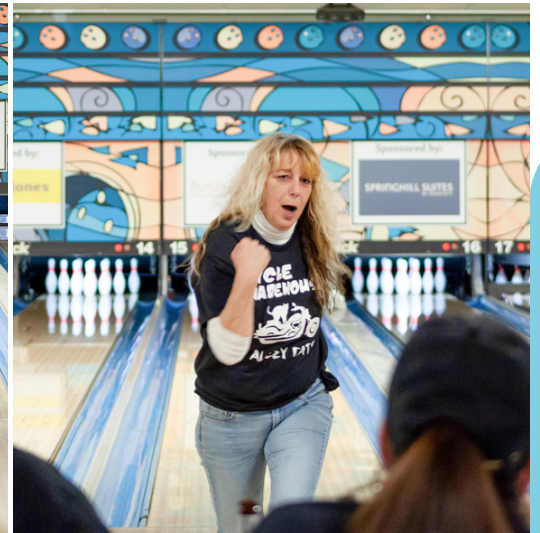

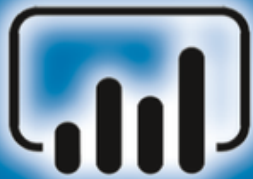
