# Sensory-Friendly

## Andy Warhol Museum

The Museum offers engaging gallery and studio experiences for teens and adults with autism spectrum disorders and sensory activities. Visit the Andy Warhol Museum's calendar on their website for upcoming programs.

## Children's Museum

Sensory friendly afternoons are offered on the second Tuesday of each month from 1-5pm. Lights and sounds throughout the museum are adjusted. Sensory kits with noise canceling headphones, weighted neck wraps, sunglasses, fidgets and other items are available. There are also several quiet areas where families can take a break.

## Carnegie Museum of Natural History

During Sensory Friendly Hours, the museum will open its galleries at 8:30am, 90 minutes before the museum opens to the general public. Guest will be permitted to visit the museum opens for a quieter experience in a more controlled environment. Museum experts will give tours of the exhibitions and be on hand to answer questions. There will also be designated quiet zones during this time. Advance registration is required for sensory friendly Saturdays.
